<http://www.npr.org/> - begin reviewing the National Public Radio website. Familiarize yourself with the various news stories and items of interest.

1. Choose a current event that has been addressed on NPR. It should be a current event that stays in the news for more than 1 or 2 days. Record the days it is covered on NPR. Listen to the broadcast about your current event. Go to the website: <https://www.npr.org/> Read the article or text reporting the current event. Summarize the broadcast report - 200- 300 words. Determine its line of reasoning. Explain the line of reasoning.
2. Using what you learned in Capstone Seminar, use 4 different lenses to examine the current event you chose. For each of the 4 lenses, you will need to find an additional source on your current event that will address each lens – total 4 additional sources. The additional sources must be printed and retained to be submitted with your assignment. After reading the additional source, explain how that lens reveals a different perspective on your current event. Each explanation should be 200-300 words.
3. Last, create an electronic presentation on your current event and the 4 perspectives of that current event. Be prepared to present this to educate your peers. Your presentation should do the following:
 - a. Explain the current event
 - b. Why you chose the current event
 - c. Line of reasoning
 - d. Each of the 4 perspectives
