#### **School and Parent Collaboration**


- Our school offers workshops, training, and parent/teacher conferences at flexible meeting times and a Parent Resource Center/Area;

#### **Parents Right-to-Know**

- Parents have the right to request and receive timely information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's teachers and paraprofessionals.
- Parents must be notified if their child is assigned to, or taught, by a teacher who does not meet state certification requirements for the grade level or subject area for four (4) or more consecutive weeks.
- Parents should be provided information regarding the level of academic achievement of their child on State required academic assessments.
- To the extent that it is feasible, information must be in a language that parents can understand.





## **Consultation and Complaint Procedures**

A student, parent or employee, who in good faith believes that the District has violated federal law and state regulatory guidance pertaining to the delivery of the Title I services and programs, in which the allegations cannot be resolved with the school site administrators and Region administrators, may file a formal complaint by submitting a written allegation within 30 days of the incident to the **Department of Title I Administration**.
